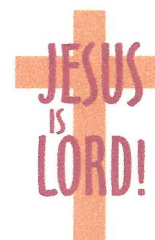


Green Christian School 2021-2022

Fall Field Trip:

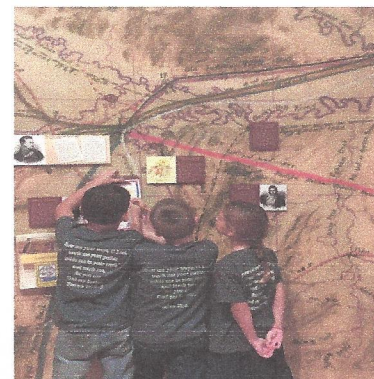

Veteran's Day:

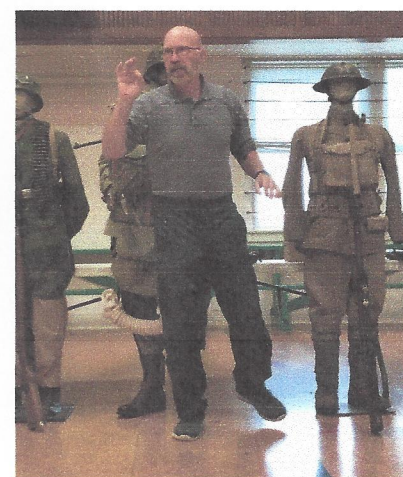

Green Public School Alumni:

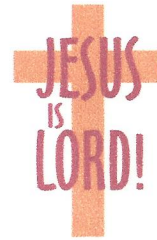
Green Alumni held a class reunion at the EUB church which is now a community center. The Green Christian School building was available for the alumni to tour.
